

Dear 7th and 8th Grade Parents and Students,

Welcome to Literature! I am looking forward to working with you and your child. I have missed them terribly during distance learning! My goal this year is to help your child to find their inner reader...even if it is buried deep, deep, deep inside! Reading should be enjoyable. It doesn't have to be a task to accomplish.

Thus....7th and 8th graders' summer reading assignment this year is to read!!!! I am not assigning projects, reports or papers. All students are to pick AR books at the 5.0 level or above. They should be either MG or MG+. UG tends to indicate less appropriate content. Book levels can be located by using the AR Book Finder website. Commonsensemedia.org is a great reference for determining the appropriateness of a title. Amazon also provides great synopses when trying to decide on a book. Your child should really try to find something that interests them or piques their curiosity. **Students must spread out their reading over the ENTIRE summer, not squeeze it all in during August. I am asking that they read 20 minutes at least 3 days a week...that's just one total hour!** This is nothing compared to cramming hours in at the end of the summer. Minutes must be logged on the calendars provided each day after reading, and a parent must initial. This means that I am looking for a MINIMUM of 3 boxes marked each and every week from Jun 15th through August 7th. **If the box is NOT filled out thoroughly, it will not count as an entry.**

In addition, students must use the bingo sheet to add a bit more creativity to our summer reading. Parents should date and initial each square as they see their child finish them. One 20 minute reading session could fill both a day on the calendar and a square of the bingo board. **You may not mark more than one bingo square on any particular day.** Each student must get 1 bingo before the first full day of school... either across, down or diagonally. If a student gets more than 1 bingo, he or she will be eligible for a drawing with fabulous prizes. The more bingos they make, the more chances to win.

Lastly all students must read 1 book cover to cover. They will be required to share with their classmates a synopsis on their books as well as their view on if others might like to read it.. Obviously, I'd love them to read more books than that, but of course

some books are much longer than others!

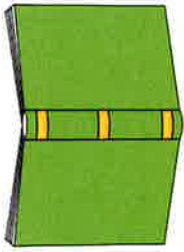
Enjoy your summer, and this year, try to add a little more reading to it! I look forward to hearing all about it in August.
